

ACT

The ACT, which consists of four academic tests that measure educational development (English, math, reading, and science reasoning) is recommended or required by more than 2,700 post-secondary institutions. Before you choose a test date, consider application deadlines of the colleges and scholarship agencies that are of interest to you. It will take four weeks after a test date for ACT to mail your score report.

If you do not score as well as you believe you can, there will be opportunities to retake the ACT during the year and still have the new information available in time to meet admission and scholarship deadlines but you must be responsible enough to keep track of deadline dates all year long.

Registration packets containing all the information necessary to register and prepare for the Assessment are available in the Student Services department. The basic registration fee for the 2018-19 Assessment is \$50.50. The fee for the ACT Plus Writing is \$67.00. You can also register online at www.actstudent.org using a MasterCard or VISA and take up to 72 hours to complete and submit your record.
