

OPEN CAMPUS FORM

- Open Campus is a privilege, not a student right.
- Open Campus is granted to CHS Seniors under the following stipulations:
 1. Senior MUST have completed 19 or more total credits in order to receive Open Campus
 2. Senior MUST have completed 3 credits of Math AND Science
 3. Senior MUST not have any “F’s” or “Incompletes” on their transcript from the previous term
 4. Senior MUST have scored a 2 or higher on the Smarter Balance Math and Science Assessments.
 - i. If student scored a 1 on either of the assessments, they will NOT have Open Campus for the first term.
 5. Senior MUST complete all requirements for their SDMyLife Portfolio by the end of first term
 6. Senior MUST visit with their assigned School Counselor for their Senior Conference by the end of second term.
 - i. If student does not complete their Senior Conference with their assigned School Counselor, they will NOT have Open Campus for third term
 - ii. Students are assigned a School Counselor by the first letter of their last name.
 1. A-G: Mr. Hehn
 2. H-O: Mr. Nygaard
 3. P-Z: Mrs. Knuppe
 7. Seniors who are failing one or more class(es) throughout the school year:
 - i. Open Campus blocks will be taken away and you will be required to report to the ICU room or B113 to work on missing assignments and/or late work
 - ii. Failure to report will result in a detention
 - iii. Failure to serve the detention will result in your Open Campus privileges being revoked for future terms
 - iv. You will get your Open Block back once ALL classes are being passed
 8. Seniors who are eligible at the beginning of the school year, may earn a total of FOUR Open Campus blocks to be used throughout the year.
 - i. Students cannot use more than two open blocks in one term
 - ii. Seniors who earn Open Campus at a later term will have the total number of Open Campus blocks reduced by one block per term.
 9. Seniors MUST fill out an Open Campus Form. Students may sign the form for themselves if they are 18 years of age. If they are under 18 years of age, they will need to have a parent or guardian sign the consent form.
