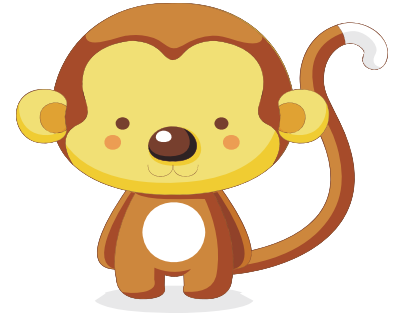


Red Ribbon Week Celebration

Red Ribbon Week has been established nationally to honor the memory of a former drug enforcement officer who was killed during duty. The officer stated that although he was one person, he wanted to make a difference. Several agencies have helped organize the Red Ribbon Campaigns in order to make a difference and adopted the red ribbon as their symbol of choice. CCL’s Counseling Program is sponsoring this event to help us become aware of the choices we have.
