

A special meeting of the School Board was held Tuesday, February 1, 2011, at the District Service Center, 1224 S 3rd Street.

The meeting was called to order by President Sharp at 6:30 PM with the following members present: Mr. Duane Alm, Mr. Brad Olson, Mr. Mike Miller, Dr. Linda Burdette, Mr. Brian Sharp and Mr. Scott Wirth. Mr. Bob Nikolas was absent.

Call to Order

The Simmons addition will include a larger gym, two fifth grade classrooms, new bathrooms and a kitchen, said Tom Hurlbert of Hula design/build. The new construction will have the same style as the existing building, including matching brick and windows.

The remodeling portion will include raising the current gym, which is 4 feet below grade and is not very accessible. That section will also include two classrooms. It will make Simmons Elementary an 18 section school. The project will also include renovation of the administrative offices if the budget allows.

Outside, a storm sewer inlet will be installed to carry water into the city storm sewer system to correct a drainage problem.

Dirt work is set to begin on the addition on March 1. The remodeling portion will begin once school is out, with expected completion in mid-August, before school starts.

It was moved by Wirth and seconded by Olson to adjourn the meeting at 6:55 PM.
