It was reported the Aberdeen School District through open enrollment for the 2013-14 has received 24 incoming students and lost 32 students to area schools. 209 transfer requests have been received, of those, 195 (93%) requests have been approved, 16 (7%) requests were denied due to lack of space.

Dr. Gary Harms reviewed the PISA Scores (Program for International Student Assessment). The scores indicate the United States scores above all other countries in spite of having the highest poverty rate.
