Jess Falken presented the Treasurer's report. The current balance in the checking account is \$25,585.67. The savings account has \$6,452.95. Deposits include \$40 from 8 new members in October and \$265 from previous membership dues. \$20,716 from the Red Wheel Fundraiser., \$261.57 from Coca Cola and a \$31 donation.

Bills presented at the meeting were \$34 to SD PTA, \$221.00 from WEB Water, \$150 to AIM Insurance and \$13,796.02 to Red Wheel.

Fundraiser Update

We sold about \$20,800 worth of product vs. \$15,500 last year for a profit of \$7,003.
