EMPLOYEE CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK - REGULATIONS

Crimes of violence as defined in SDCL 22-1-2(9) include any of the following crimes or an attempt to commit, or a conspiracy to commit any of the following:

- Murder
- Manslaughter
- Rape
- Aggravated assault
- Riot
- Robbery
- Burglary in the first or second degree
- Arson
- Kidnapping
- Felony sexual contact as defined in SDCL 22-22-7

Any other felony in the commission of which the perpetrator used force, or was armed with a dangerous weapon, or used any explosive or destructive device.

A sex offense as defined in SDCL 22-24B-1 includes the following crimes regardless of the date of the commission of the offense or the date of conviction:

- Rape
- Sexual contact with a minor under sixteen
- Sexual contact with a person incapable of consenting
- Incest
- Possessing, manufacturing or distributing child pornography
- Sale of child pornography
- Sexual exploitation of a minor
- Kidnapping if the victim of the criminal act is a minor
- Promotion of prostitution of a minor
- Criminal pedophilia
- Felony indecent exposure
- Solicitation of a minor
- Bestiality
- An attempt to commit any of the crimes listed in this section
- Any crime committed in a place other than this state which would constitute a sex crime under this section if committed in this state
- Any federal crime or court martial that would constitute a sex crime under federal law

Moral turpitude as defined in SDCL 22-1-2(25) is an act done contrary to justice, honesty, principle, or good morals, as well as an act of baseness, vileness, or depravity in the private and social duties which a person owes to his fellow man or to society in general.
