HEALTH

EMPLOYEE HEALTH

The School Board recognizes its responsibility to provide a safe and healthy working environment for its employees. If, at any time, there is reasonable cause to believe that an employee is suffering from a mental or physical condition that could be detrimental to the health or safety of the employee, any student, or any other employee, the Superintendent may require a certificate of health. The expense of obtaining such certifications of health shall be borne by the school.

When working together in a school, employees may be exposed to a variety of communicable diseases which may affect their personal health or the health of fellow employees. The Aberdeen School District will formulate regulations for communicable disease reporting and exclusion from work and regulations to eliminate or minimize employee occupational exposure to blood and other disease transmitting sources.
