STUDENT PHYSICALS FOR SCHOOL ATHLETICS

Students wishing to take part in interscholastic athletics must have on file with the School District a copy of a physical examination performed by a qualified health care provider. Physicals are required on a tri-annual basis. During the second and third years of the tri-annual physical period, an Interim Pre-Participation History form must be completed and signed by a parent/guardian and, if necessary, a qualified health provider.

The School District will provide an opportunity for the students to have the required physical examination in the spring of each year. The physicals will require a nominal fee covering the cost of the medical personnel involved. Physical examinations for students must be conducted after April 1 to be considered applicable for the tri-annual physical status.

The parents/guardians have the option of having their child receive the required physical examination by a qualified health care provider at their own expense. In such cases, only the proper forms are to be used. These forms must be properly completed and signed by the parent/guardian and the attending qualified health care provider.

No student shall be denied participation in interscholastic athletics due to a hardship surrounding the payment of a nominal fee for the physical examination.
