ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS

Children of school age who are residents of Aberdeen School District 6-1 may attend school without payment of tuition.

Children who are citizens of a foreign country will be considered residents if they meet all of the following requirements:

- The child resides with his/her parents or legal guardian within the boundaries of Aberdeen School District 6-1;
- The child is in the United States under a visa other than a visitor's visa or a student visa; and
- The child is a participant in a foreign student exchange program approved by the Superintendent.

The School Board has the legal authority to determine which school a student will attend. Generally, students will be required to attend school in the attendance area in which they reside, unless special permission has been granted at the discretion of the Superintendent or his/her designee. The residence of the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) will determine the legal address.
