ADMISSION OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS

The Aberdeen School District will accept all students who are legal residents of another South Dakota district that wish to enroll, provided the District's facilities are able to accommodate the students without adversely affecting the quality of the educational program. The determination of whether the District's facilities can accommodate a particular student will be determined solely by the District.

The District may deny application for any of the following additional reasons:

1. The application was not timely;
2. The applicant has been convicted of possession, use, or distribution of any controlled substance, including marijuana, and is under suspension pursuant to SDCL 13-32-4.3;
3. The applicant is under suspension or expulsion pursuant to SDCL 13-32-4.3;
4. The applicant has been convicted of a weapons charge relating to the schools and is under suspension pursuant to SDCL 13-32-4.3.
5. Students who are citizens of a foreign country with clarification of a visa.

Once enrolled in a nonresident district, the enrollment will continue unless a bona fide change of residence occurs or a subsequent transfer application is approved.

Transportation is the responsibility of the parent.
